

The latest documentary from Prairie Public Television's series on the influence of Germans from Russia premiered to rave reviews at the 2010 GRHS National Convention. It has been shown on several public TV stations, and now we have a chance to view it for ourselves.

The Murdered Family: A Novel Based On A True Story

North Dakota native Vernon Keel will read from his book, *The Murdered Family*, published in 2010 for the 90th anniversary of the murders of the seven members of the Jacob Wolf family of Turtle Lake, McLean County, North Dakota.

Dr. Keel will also discuss the ethnic aspects of this story, relating to the German-Russian origins of the murdered family and the accused murderer, and also how ethnicity affected perceptions of guilt and innocence among members of the community, many of which were revealed to the author after the book was published.

This terrible tragedy of the mass murder of a family, followed by a hasty investigation and a confession, had several sub-plots, and Dr. Keel's presentation will include time for questions.
